The Holy spirit Is given personal characteristics and experiences 1 Cor 11:21 - He has a will – Isaiah 63:10 - Eph 4:30 – He can be grieved Acts 5:3 – He can be lied to and takes offense

The Holy spirit is distinguished from His power - Romans 15:13

The Holy Spirit stands with Other persons as a person – John 14 Acts 15:28 Matthew 28:19
